



Alstroemeria Colorita® 'Lisa' - located in Jungle Bed Zones 8-10 Bright Yellow Flowers Full sun, part shade Deciduous tuberous perennial Evenly moist, well-draining soil Longlasting cut flowers Acid, neutral, alkaline soil Low maintenance 1'x2' Also known as Peruvian Lilies

Bright yellow flowers have a faintly speckled throat, contrasting beautifully with glossy green foliage. An excellent, long lasting cut flower. Blooms continuously during the warm season when spent flower stems are plucked promptly. Fine for massed plantings or as an accent in ground or containers. An herbaceous perennial.

Plant in classical urns or terra cotta pots. Gang them in window boxes and trough planters. Equally happy in the garden where its versatility fits a variety of garden styles. Takes on a traditional cottage garden character when integrated into perennial borders. A valuable source of flower color in tropical gardens too heavy on foliage plants. Spot into foundation plantings at high traffic areas to appreciate the stellar flowers. A perfect cutting garden candidate.

Peruvian lilies are native to the rich soils of the mountain regions of South America, Chile and Brazil. The introduction of the alstroemeria to Europe is credited to 18th century botanist, Claus von Alstroemer of Sweden, hence the botanical name.
