



**Callistemon 'Little John' ☼**  
**Dwarf Bottlebrush 3x5 Red Z8 E**

**Callistemon viminalis 'Little John' - located in Madrona Bed Zone 8-11 Evergreen Low, average water Drought Tolerant**

**Low maintenance Acid, neutral soil Callistemon viminalis is also known as Weeping Bottlebrush, Creek Bottlebrush**

Full sun-part shade; low water. Evergreen small shrub native to Australia. Slow growing, dwarf form to 3ft tall and 3-5ft wide, with dense growth pattern. Narrow, bluish gray-green leaves. Blood red bristle-like stamens; hence the common name bottlebrush, appear throughout the year, but peak bloom is early summer through fall. Attracts bees and hummingbirds. Good for mass plantings, as a foundation plant, or a low hedge.

With its lower spreading habit, this hummingbird magnet fits into any garden. Use as a foundation cover-up in drought-resistant gardens or as middle-of-the-border accent plants. Line up several for a hedge or mass them like groundcover in very hot planting areas where other plants wilt. Ideal for desert landscapes.
