

Chinese Windmill Palm & Trachycarpus fortunei 6x10 E Z8

Trachycarpus fortunei - located in Sun Bed Zones 7-11 Dioecious Full Sun, part sun Evergreen Mulch in Winter Drought tolerant 6'x10' Light yellow Flowers Protect from Winds

Extremely hardy, *Tracycarpus fortunei*, or Chinese Windmill Palm, is a small evergreen palm that forms a single stout trunk topped by a terminal tuft of stiff deeply divided dark green fan-shaped leaves that can measure up to 3 feet wide. Dark hairy fibers cover the trunk.

Easy to grow, the Windmill Palm is dioecious, with separate male and female plants. It produces large dangling sprays of small flowers in summer, followed by dark blue fruits. The female flowers are green and the male flowers are yellow.

Native to subtropical and temperate mountain forests of China, it can survive short periods at 5° F (-15° C).

Water on a regular basis. Plant in well-draining soil. Can be propagated by seed, which can take up to three months to germinate.
