

Delphinium elatum 'Highlander Bolero' - located in Delphinium Bed Ruffled Double Lavender-Blue with White Eye Zones 4-8 Full sun, part shade Herbaceous Perennial Water regularly Prefers ALKALINE Soil Fertilize regularly 2'x4' Stake

The double lavender-blue flowers with a cream center are ruffled, a style of flower not often seen in a Delphiniums. Developed in Scotland, the sturdy spikes are excellent as cut flowers.

When in flower, the spikes become heavy and should be staked to avoid toppling over in rough weather, especially taller varieties.

The densely packed blossoms are sterile and therefore long-lasting, blooming for weeks from early to mid summer. Deer and rabbit resistant. Remove spent spikes to promote another round of blooms in late summer or early fall
