

Enkianthus 'Red Bells' C Red-Rimmed Cream Flowers D 3x5 Z8

Enkianthus campanulatus 'Red Bells' - located in ? Zones 6-8 Red-Rimmed Bell-shaped Cream Flowers Full sun, part shade Deciduous Shrub Water regularly in summer Bold Yellow, Orange and Red Fall Color Slow growing 3'x5'

The name describes the red rims of the otherwise cream-colored, drooping bell-shaped flowers, but the real ornamental value of this shrub is its bold yellow, orange, and red fall color and its tiered habit, which is best appreciated in winter. Shade tolerant. Grows slowly.

Enkianthus is a great companion plant for rhododendrons. Deer resistant.
