



## Fuchsia 'Celia Smedley' © CE Z8 2x3 Pale Pink/Strawberry-red D U

Fuchsia 'Celia Smedley' - located in Jungle Bed Pale Pink tube and sepals / Strawberry-Red Corolla Single Flowers Bushy Rigidly Upright Zones 8-10 Profuse bloomer Exceptionally Hardy Full sun, part shade Deciduous Perennial Water regularly Fertilize regularly 2'x3'

"Celia Smedley" is a vigorous, rigidly upright fuchsia with medium to large single flowers adorned with pale pink sepals and a bright strawberry-red corolla that contrast well with large mid-green leaves. Blooms non-stop from early summer to fall.

Parentage: Chance seedling Pepi

In early to mid-spring, cut back the previous year's flowering stems to within a bud or two of the older woody framework. Remove any thin, weak or dead growth to stimulate strong new growth on which flowers will be produced in late summer.

Add the beautiful flowers to salads, crystallize them for a sweet garnish or add them to jellies for an extra splash of color.
