



Fuchsia 'Groenekans Glory' - located in Upper Loop Coral pink tube and sepals / Coral Corolla Single Flowers Bushy Upright Zones 8-10 Profuse bloomer Full sun, part shade Deciduous Perennial Water regularly Fertilize regularly 30"x30"

The sepals of the inch-and-a-half flowers curve downward at an interesting angle. Their tubes are dappled with coral pink; their sepals are coral pink fading to pale green at the tip; and their corollas are vibrant coral. The young foliage is light green turning to mid-green as it matures.

In early to mid-spring, cut back the previous year's flowering stems to within a bud or two of the older woody framework. Remove any thin, weak or dead growth to stimulate strong new growth on which flowers will be produced in late summer.

Add the beautiful flowers to salads, crystallize them for a sweet garnish or add them to jellies for an extra splash of color.
