

Fuchsia "Pat's Dream" - located in Upper Loop Zones 7-11 Single flowers with red sepals above a lilac purple corolla Sun, Part Shade Herbaceous Perennial Water regularly Fertilize regularly 3'x3'

Fuchsia "Pat's Dream" is a repeat-blooming upright shrub that bears pendulous medium single flowers with red sepals above a lilac purple corolla. Not patented

In early to mid-spring, cut back the previous year's flowering stems to within a bud or two of the older woody framework. Remove any thin, weak or dead growth to stimulate strong new growth on which flowers will be produced in late summer.

Parentage -

Add to salads, crystallize them for a sweet garnish or add them to jellies for an extra splash of color.
