



## Hypericum 'Chardonnay' 3x3 Z8 Yellow Flowers & Berries

Hypericum x inodorum (St. John's Wort) 'Chardonnay' - located in Pastiche Bed Zones 5-9 Sunny Yellow Flowers produce Bright Yellow Berries Full sun, part shade Semi-deciduous Shrub Water regularly Easy Care Prune late fall or early spring before flower buds set 3'x3'

Sunny yellow flowers produce clusters of bright yellow berries on well-branched, rust resistant plants with handsome dark green foliage. A fuss-free deciduous shrub ideal for borders and containers. Use as a specimen or low hedge, or plant in showy drifts. Stems of fall berries are a wonderful accent in cut flower arrangements.

FloralBerry™ Chardonnay is completely covered in bright, yellow flowers in spring. Each fall, the plant is blanketed in luminous yellow berries on a fuss-free shrub. Ideal for borders and mixed containers, this Hypericum also stands out when mass planted in showy drifts. A shrub that contributes to the indoors as well as out, ornate, fruiting stems are excellent to add to early autumn floral displays.

Prune to shape in early spring before flowers appear or after fruiting in the fall. Plants should not be pruned after flower buds are set.
