Papavar orientale 'Princess Victoria Louise' - located in Palm Bed Zones 3-8 Salmon-Pink Flowers Full sun Herbaceous Perennial Acid, Neutral, Alkaline Soil 2'x3' Care-free Deer, Rabbit & Drought Tolerant Goes Dormant after Flowering in Late Spring Self-Seeds

Oriental Poppy 'Princess Victoria Louise' is a feast for the eyes with its large, crepe papery, cup-shaped, salmon-pink flowers with a dark purple eye and black splotches at their base.

When planting poppies, be aware that the aboveground growth dies back in summer, when the plant goes dormant. This can leave gaps in your planting bed, so plant around the flowers accordingly.
